STUDENT PROJECT SCHEME 2018-19

Objective

The objective of this scheme is to develop and utilize the tremendous student talent and potential available in our state and to use them for solving specific science and technology problems relevant and useful to our society.

Financial support

Department of Science & Technology, Government of India under its State Science & Technology programme has been implementing the “Student Project Scheme” through various state councils. For this financial contribution of State S&T Councils/State Government are needed. The total State S&T contribution will be Rs. 60 lakhs with Rs. 20 lakhs in each year.

The scheme is meant for final year students of Degree/Diploma in Engineering in any discipline. Under this scheme financial support will be provided to encourage students who have dissertation work in their regular curriculum to take up useful minor research projects. They will be provided with a grant of Rs. 8000/- per project per year. Seminar-cum-exhibition of the projects undertaken by the students will have to be organized every year. The students will have to present their findings before the Project Evaluation Committee. The sanction order for the project proposals will be dispatched to respective engineering college/polytechnics in the name of the Principal and copy to HOD and concerned Guide of the project.

Guidelines

- The project should be performed based on the objectives of the proposal.
- The project should be completed in all respects. One hard copy of the full report along with softcopy in a CD (.pdf format) should be submitted to BCST.
- Any change in the project title and objectives etc. or students will be liable to rejection of the project and the amount sanctioned will have to be returned back to BCST.
- Every sanctioned project will have a Project Sanction Reference Number (PSRN). The project sanctioned reference number will have to be quoted in all future correspondences.

- After completing the project, 2-3 page write-up (synopsis) has to be submitted to BCST clearly mentioning the following:

Title of the project

1. Name of the College & Department
2. Name of the Students & Guide(s) (with email id and contact no.)
3. Introduction/Background (with specific reference to the project, work done earlier etc.) – about 20 lines
4. Objectives (about 10 lines)
5. Methodology (about 30 lines) (materials, methods, details of work carried out including drawings, diagrams etc.)
6. Results and Conclusions (about 20 lines with specific reference to work carried out)
7. Scope of future work (about 20 lines)
8. Projects selected for Seminar cum Exhibition will be awarded with prize books and certificates.

Submission of proposal

The softcopy of the above said write-up should be forwarded to BCST (by post/email) through the project guide indicating the PSRN in the subject line.
