Sir,

I am directed to refer to Minister, RCD, Bihar, Patna's letter no. 11/meeting-17-08/2017-9239 (S) dated 05.12.2018 and Principal Secretary, Bihar letter no. 11/meeting-17-08/2017 dated 25.09.2018 and 15.10.2018 on the subject mentioned above and to convey the administrative approval of the President of India for an amount of Rs. 693.70 crore (Rupees Six Hundred Ninety Three Crore and Seventy Lakh only) based on the applicable Schedule of Rates, to meet cost of work debitible to the allocations of the Govt. of Bihar under Central Road Fund (State Roads) Rules 2014, for the work mentioned below:-

2. You may now accord technical and financial sanction of the project and award the work within a period of four months from the date of receipt of the sanction, failing which the work will be deemed to have been deleted from the programme in the light of Central Road Fund (State Roads) Rules 2014. No excess in cost beyond 10% of the amount administratively approved for that work will be permissible. Any excess over 10% will have to be arranged by the State from their own resources. No revised estimate will be considered in this scheme.
3. This approval is accorded subject to the following conditions: -
- 3.1 The total expenditure on all works in the State approved for being financed out of Central Road Fund (Allocation) does not at any time exceed the amount actually available therein;
- 3.2 The stipulations made under Central Road Fund (State Roads) Rules, 2014 should be strictly followed.
- 3.3 The work should be completed within a period of twenty four months as per Central Road Fund (State Roads) Rules, 2014.
- 3.4 The quarterly progress reports of all the works sanctioned from Central Road Fund should be furnished to this Ministry within one month from the date of ending of each quarter.
- 3.5 Government of Bihar should furnish completion certificate duly vetted by Audit after completion of works as per the stipulations made in Central Road Fund (State Roads) Rules, 2014
- 3.6 Government of Bihar should furnish the Utilization Certificate in Form-I (enclosed with Central Road Fund (State Roads) Rules, 2014) duly verified by the Regional Officer appointed by the Central Government for the State along with the quarterly progress report based on which further installments of Funds shall be released to the extent of expenditure incurred and the physical progress of the work, provided that, the total amount so released during any financial year shall not exceed the amount accrued to the State or Union Territory during that financial year and the amount which has not been released from accruals of the previous years.
- 3.7 The stipulation made in Ministry's letter No. RW/NH-33044/10/2002-S&R (R), dated 26.05.2003 & 31.12.2003 regarding display boards on the schemes sanctioned under CRF should be strictly followed.

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- 3.8 The additional funds beyond the actual accrual for completion of these works shall be met by the State Government from its own resources;
- 3.9 The progress and completion of the works shall not be hampered due to want of funds.
- 3.10 The State Government shall ensure the completion of works within stipulated time.
4. The work has been assigned Job Number as mentioned in above table against each work. This Job number may be quoted in all future correspondence relating to the work.
5. The expenditure is debitable under the Major Head "3601" Grants-in-Aid to State Govts (Major Head); 02-Grants for State Plan Schemes (Sub Major Head); 02.105-Grants from Central Road Fund (Minor Road); 01.00.35-Grants for Creation of Capital Assets corresponding to Demand No.81-Ministry of Road Transport & Highways for the year 2018-19.
