

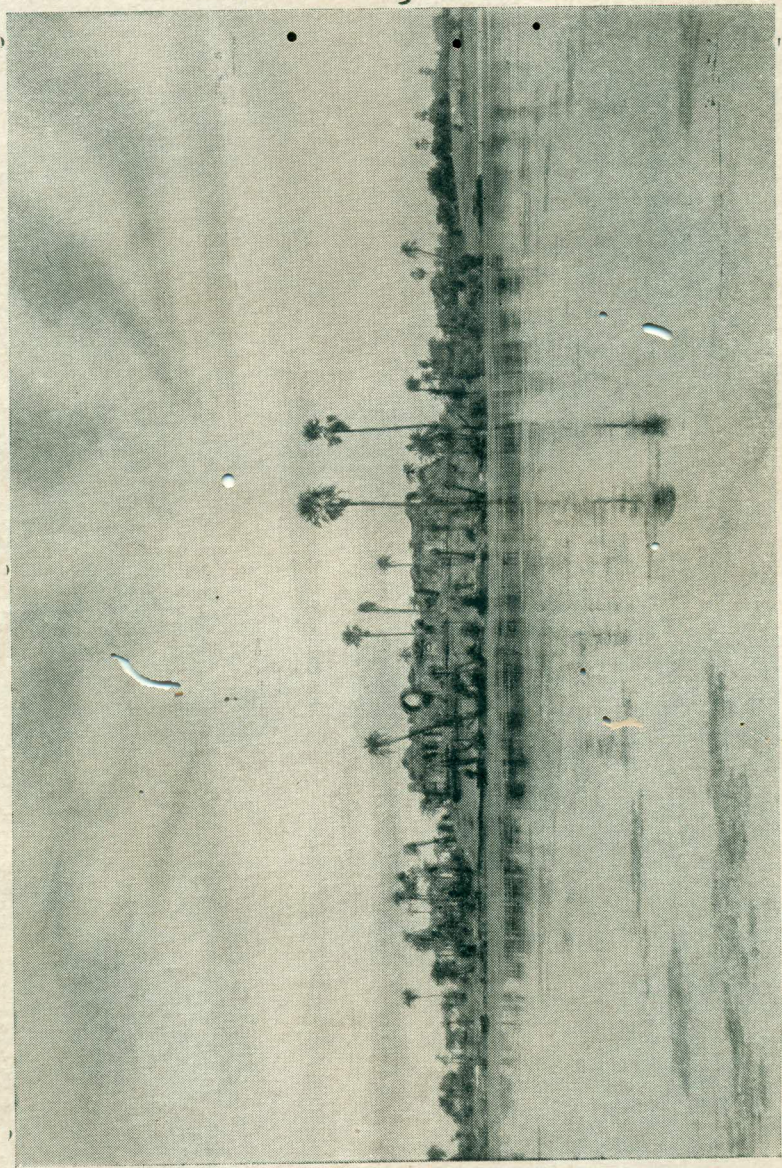

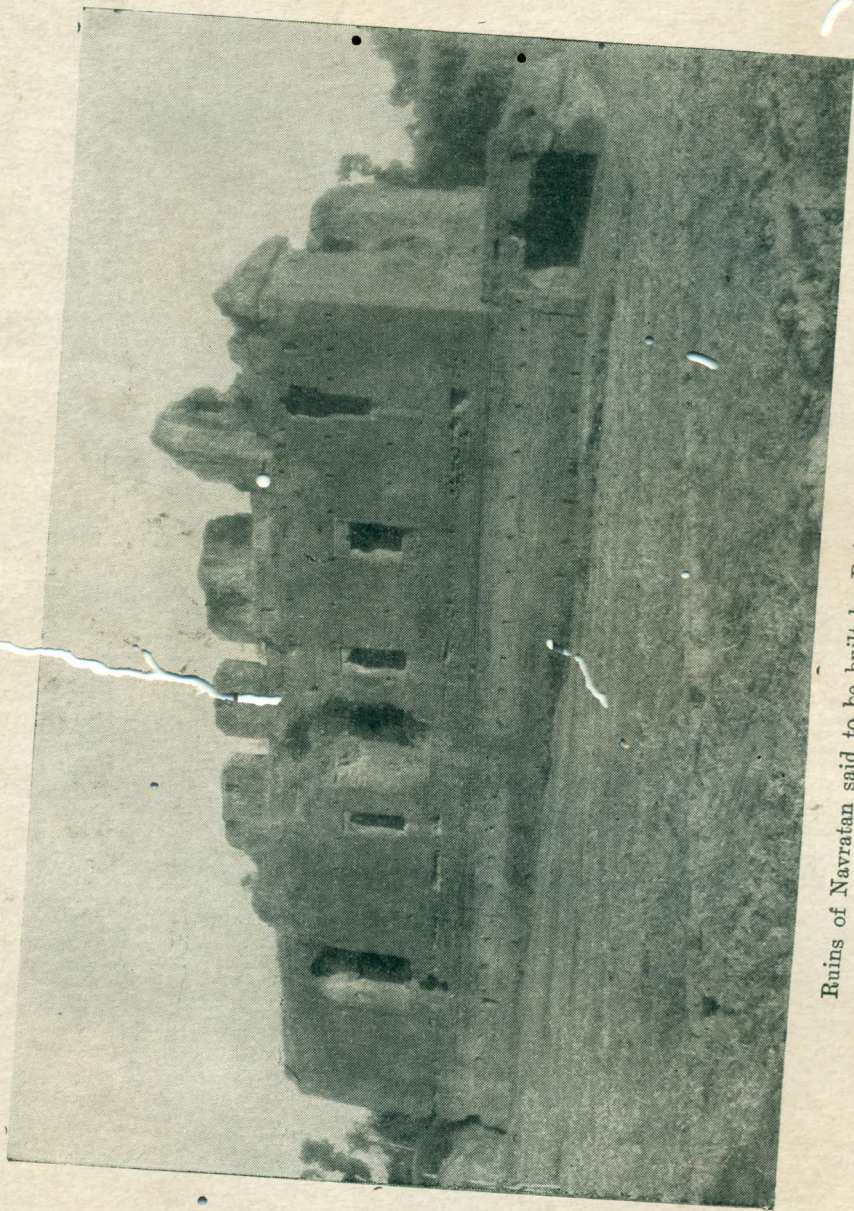
A portion of a stone slab showing the images of Ketu, Rahu, Sani and Venus, a specimen of the Eastern School of Mediaeval Art.



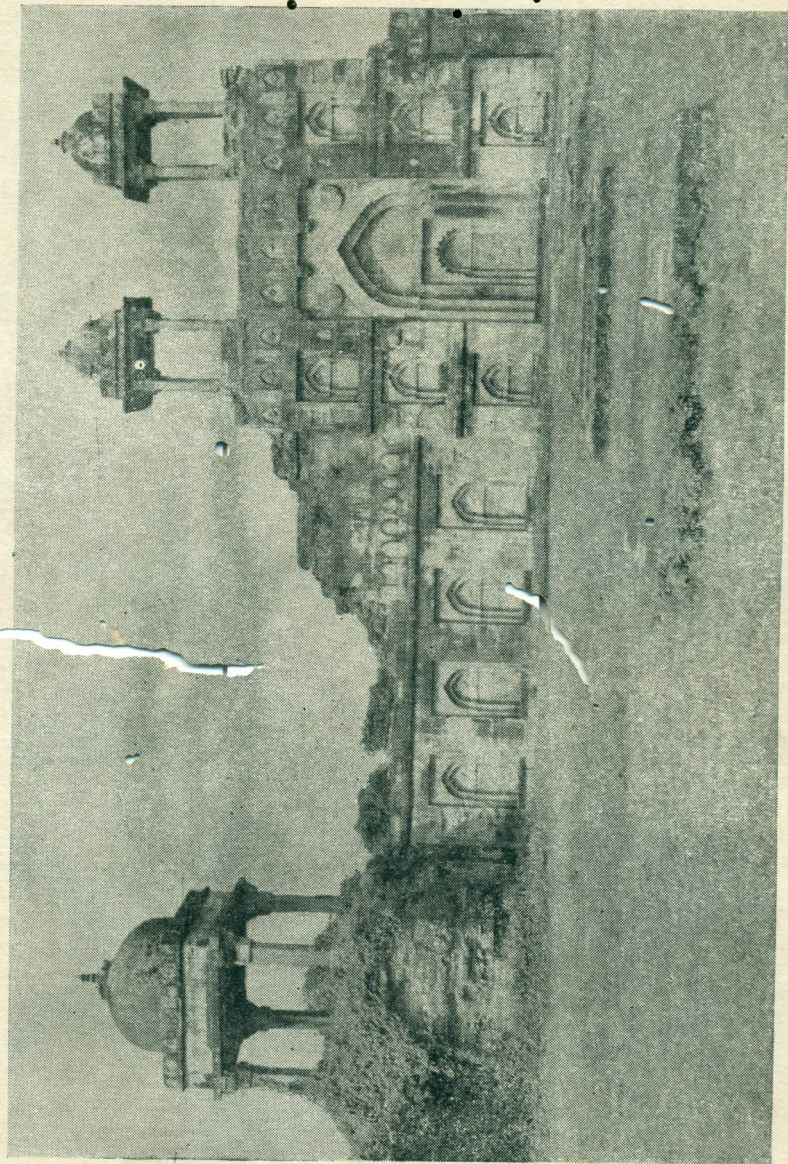
Dhuadhar Waterfall, about 10 miles from Sasaram.



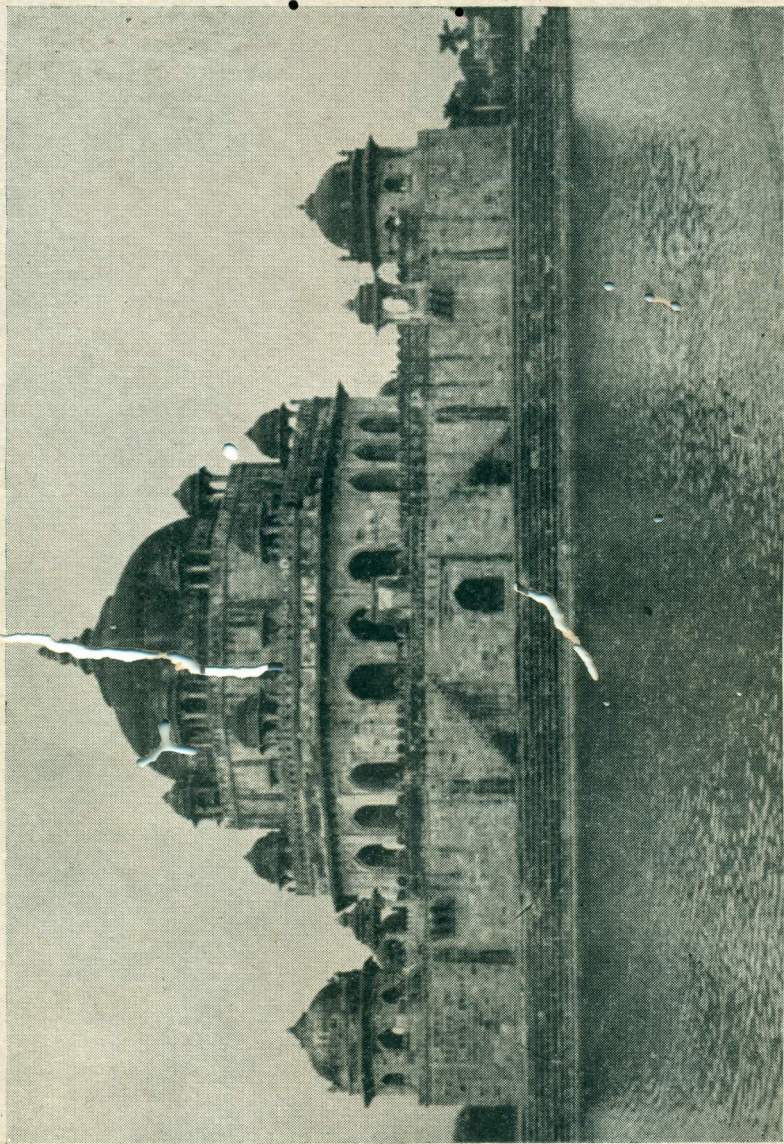
Alwal Khan's tomb.

Sher Shah's tomb at Sasaram.



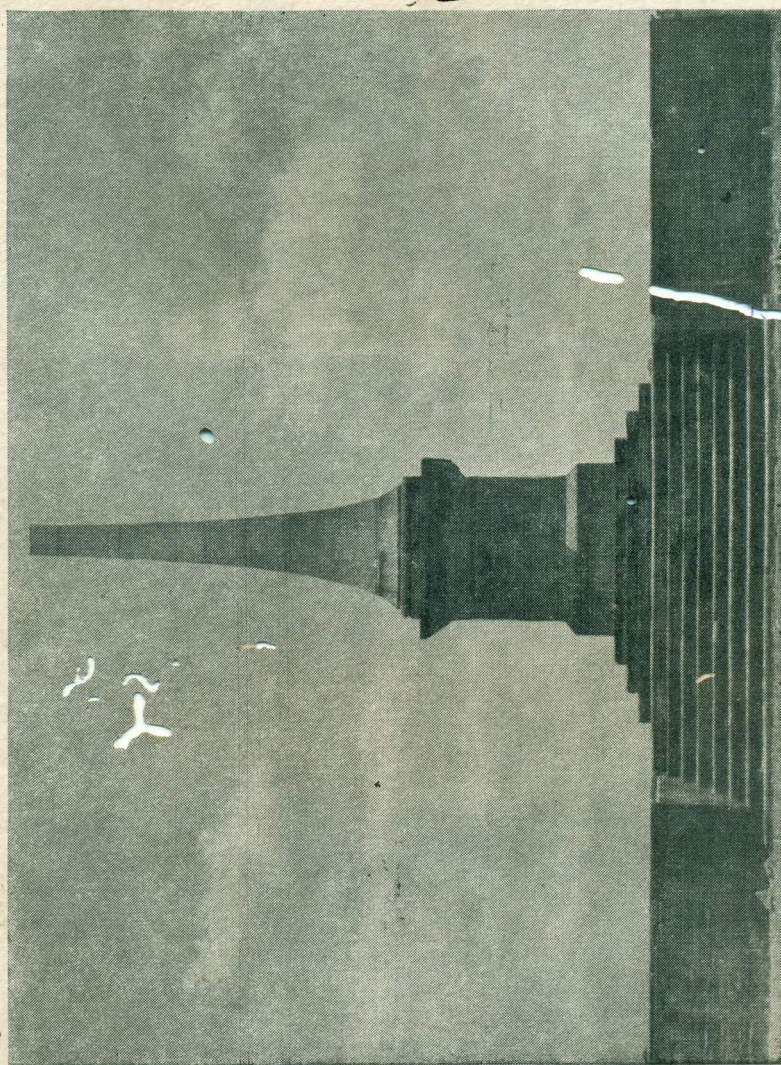
An image of Tarka demon at Buxar.
