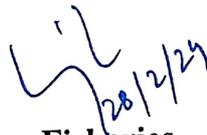

## 2. Request For Proposal

Directorate of Fisheries, Animal and Fisheries Resources Department, GoB hereby invites proposals in the form of techno-financial bids from interested and technically qualified agencies for deployment as Project Implementation and Monitoring Unit for technical support and implementation of fisheries development schemes in Bihar.

The proposal has to be submitted offline at Director Fisheries, Directorate of Fisheries, Animal and Fisheries Resources Department, Govt. of Bihar, 2nd Floor, Room No. 224, Vikas Bhawan, Bailey Road, Patna, Pin - 800001.

## 3. Background

Traditionally, Bihar's economy is dominated by rural sector. Around 88% of the population live in the rural areas. Agriculture and Dairy sub sectors have fared well in recent past. The positive impact of green revolution and white revolution can be easily visualized in Bihar. The state is endowed with adequate freshwater resources and fishery subsector has a tremendous potential. In the year 2022-23, State has achieved total fish production of 8.46 Lakh MT. The State vision towards fisheries development in Bihar comprises the following: -

- i) Ensure sustainable socio-economic development of farmers involved in fisheries and enhance Human Resource Development to make the fisheries sector an efficient and professionally managed sector. While safeguard the rights of small fishermen, encourage increased participation of women in this sector and implement schemes for welfare of fishermen.
- ii) Encourage Public Private Partnerships in all segments of the fisheries value chain. Creating an excellent environment to attract private sector investments in the fisheries sector through legislative and policy support. Assist in domestic market development through incentivization of Local bodies and private sector players to create modern cold chain and hygienic fish markets.
- iii) Promote innovation and encourage technology upgradation through Research and Development. Promote high value fishery resources and their processing for value addition through modernization of the fisheries sector by importing new technologies.
- iv) Put in place appropriate mechanisms to ensure sustainable fisheries and aquaculture to ensure ecological integrity and biodiversity. Ensure sanitary and Phyco-sanitary standards in all the stages of fisheries and aquaculture.
- v) Promote export market through quality management, packaging, labeling, marketing and Brand development.

## Project Implementation and Monitoring Cell (PIMC)

For effective rolling out of the ongoing schemes, it is planned that the PIMC would be in place for technical support, implementation, monitoring of the Central as well as State schemes and for providing manpower. The Project Implementation and Monitoring Cell

(PIMC) would provide **two hundred thirty-nine (239) manpower/resource persons** across different offices of Directorate of Fisheries, Bihar who will be placed across headquarters, districts and commissionaires/ranges.

The Project Implementation and Monitoring Cell (PIMC) will consist of two cells :

- i) Implementation and Monitoring Cell
- ii) IT Cell

It is expected that the selected Project Implementation and Monitoring Cell (PIMC) with its wide array of expertise, will bring a more holistic perspective towards technical advisory and overseeing effective scheme implementation under the aegis of Directorate of Fisheries, Animal and Fisheries Resources Department, Govt. of Bihar.

### **Request for Proposal**

Directorate of Fisheries, Animal and Fisheries Resources Department, Govt. of Bihar is issuing this Request for Proposal (RFP) for selection of an Agency for setting up a 'Technical Advisory Team' for technical support and implementation of Fisheries development Schemes for a period of **3 years/36 months**, which may be extended for a further period of **2 years/24 months** or more based on satisfactory work and mutually agreeable terms with increment of 10% of the manpower cost for each extended tenure. Also, based on performance and need of the Directorate of Fisheries, manpower under PIMC can be increased further with aforesaid increment.

### **4. Earnest Money Deposit & Bid Processing Charge**

A non-refundable tender document fee of **Rs. 8,000/-** (Rupees eight thousand only) through DD in favor of '**Director Fisheries, Bihar, Patna**' has to be submitted by the bidder along with the bid. The bid must be accompanied by a refundable **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 2,00,000/-** (Rupees two lakh only) separately in the form of Demand Draft or bank guarantee drawn in favor of **Director Fisheries, Bihar, Patna payable at any nationalized bank situated at Patna (Bihar)**. After selection of the suitable applicant for appointment as consulting firm, the amount of EMD shall be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders. Bidders may submit the EMD in the form of Demand Draft or bank guarantee. The EMD of the successful Bidder shall be retained by the Directorate till the completion of the assignment.

### **5. Terms of Reference**

#### **5.1. Scope of Work:**

The scope of work of the mentioned engagement will broadly cover the following areas:

- a) **Support for conceptualization of schemes that can help uplift the fish farmers of Bihar:** PIMC shall support in formulating strategies/sub-strategies necessary for successful implementation of fisheries development schemes implemented by the Directorate of Fisheries.
- b) **Support towards effective overseeing of the ongoing DoF activities:** PIMC shall extend support to Directorate to carry out routine assignments for smooth and effective implementation of the ongoing schemes.
  - *Convergence support:* Converging communication with requisite stakeholders for Inter and Intra Department coordination under the ambit of Directorate.

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- *Institutional strengthening support*: To assist in strengthening of fisheries Co-operatives by development and execution of capacity building modules among the fish farmers.
  - *Database management*: To develop data collection tools, coordinate and converge with offices/officials to collect data, data analysis and report preparation.
  - *Financial management*: To support in creating standard recording, analysis and reporting tools for financial transaction within the Directorate.
  - *Operational & functional management*: To develop simpler modules/processes/tools to carry out daily activities of the Directorate.
- c) **Information dissemination on fisheries schemes**: PIMC would assist State Government in organizing workshops / media campaigns / e-meets/ webinars etc. aimed at sensitizing stakeholders about various initiatives and support available under Directorate. PIMC will support Directorate in various events such as seminars, workshops, campaigns, roundtables, conferences etc. for brand promotion, awareness generation on schemes, providing thought leadership on fisheries development knowledge sharing and scheme promotion.
- PIMC would develop a year-round calendar of events for sensitization of stakeholders in the pockets of important fish production along with identifying the potential resource persons/institutes/organizations/etc.
- d) **Assistance in mobilization of proposals under schemes of the Directorate**: PIMC would assist State Government in inviting and mobilizing proposals and projects eligible for assistance under different schemes of fisheries.
- e) **Evaluation and Appraisal of Techno-feasibility reports and Detailed Project Reports (DPRs)**: PIMC will facilitate preparation of the Business Plans / DPRs for supporting investors / project proponents in application under different schemes.
- PIMC would also assist State Government in selection of projects through evaluation / appraisal of techno-feasibility reports and DPRs submitted for existing schemes at the Directorate.
- f) **Supporting capacity building of entrepreneurs/farmers in project execution and supply chain management**: PIMC would provide capacity building modules to support entrepreneurs in execution of the fish projects. Such services may include developing modules for capacity building in different technical aspects. The team will also facilitate in developing ToT and SoPs modules towards key thematic areas.
- g) **Assistance in management of the schemes**: PIMC would provide technical support in effective management of schemes (being implemented by DoF). Further, the team would facilitate development of Standard Operating Procedures (SoPs) and guidelines for fish farmers or entrepreneurs on production and operations management.
- h) **Release and Utilization of Grant**: PIMC would support State Government in planning effective release of grant support and monitoring as per the norms and guidelines GoB. The agency would develop reporting templates & tools for evaluating the grant release and its effective utilization by the beneficiary and the concerned field officials of the Directorate.

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- i) **Exploring Market linkages:** PIMC would support entrepreneurs in exploring suitable opportunities for production, processing and market linkages for fisheries projects. This will enhance the overall business success of proposals. The team will also facilitate brand enhancement for products developed by farmers / Enterprises promoted under the scheme, to enhance the market acceptance of the same.
  - j) **Monitoring and reporting:** PIMC would assist Directorate of Fisheries in effective monitoring of schemes and projects by way of providing periodic (**daily, weekly, bi-weekly, monthly, quarterly**) status updates on key schemes and projects. PIMC would review and suggest improvements in the reporting templates.  
  
The team will further assist in mid-term and annual reviews of the schemes. PIMC will also design formats for data collection, status reporting across the states and districts to meet the MIS requirements for Directorate for scheme monitoring and analysis.
  - k) **Procurement Management:** PIMC would facilitate the procurement / bid process management pertaining to schemes being implemented by Directorate. This will include facilitating the tender preparation to work award stage.
  - l) **Ground Truthing field visits:** PIMC would carry out necessary field visits in the operational areas for better visibility and ground truthing of ongoing activities, as per need of the assignment. This will be a need-based activity for augmenting the PIMC deliverables.
  - m) **Web Based Management Information System (MIS)** – Maintenance of the existing web portal, online scheme management system, need-based development in the web portal, MIS, software development, development of need-based mobile applications for scheme management, monitoring & market linkage activities, online scheme management, database management in the Directorate of Fisheries, development of project based application with online and offline features, hosting of online scheme applications at SDC on latest technologies and platform with online and offline facilities, development of online and offline financial management system for connecting the districts and preparation of utilization certificates.
  - n) **Providing manpower** – Providing the specified resources and manpower across State as per specified in the RFP.
  - o) **All other work assigned by Fisheries Directorate.**

## 5.2 Deliverables of the project

1. Preparation and implementation of Fisheries Development Schemes.
2. Day-to-day support in implementation of the schemes/convergence support for Inter and Intra Departmental coordination, providing support for institutional strengthening, database management/financial management/operational and functional management.
3. Dissemination of information related to fisheries schemes by organizing workshops/media campaigns / e-meets/ webinars etc. aimed at sensitizing various stakeholders. Also, supporting in organizing seminars, workshops, campaigns,

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- roundtables, conferences etc. for brand promotion & awareness generation on schemes.
4. Assistance to Directorate in mobilization of proposals/projects under different schemes of fisheries.
  5. Facilitating in preparation of the Business Plans / DPRs for supporting investors / project proponents in application under different schemes.
  6. Providing capacity building modules to support entrepreneurs in execution of the fish projects.
  7. Providing technical support in effective management of schemes (being implemented by DoF) along with facilitate developing of Standard operating procedures (SoPs) and guidelines for fish farmers or entrepreneurs on production and operations management.
  8. Developing reporting templates & tools for evaluating the grant release and its effective utilization by the beneficiary and the concerned field officials of the Directorate.
  9. Supporting entrepreneurs in exploring table opportunities for production, processing and market linkages for fisheries projects.
  10. Providing quarterly status updates on key schemes and projects. Assisting mid-term and annual review of the schemes and designing formats for data collection, status reporting across the states and districts to meet the MIS requirements
  11. Facilitating the procurement / bid process management pertaining to schemes and facilitating the tender preparation to work award stage.
  12. Need based field visits in the operational areas for better visibility and ground truthing of ongoing activities.
  13. Development of MIS for Fisheries Directorate, maintenance of the web portal, online scheme management system and need based development in the web portal. Development of need based mobile applications for scheme management, monitoring & market linkage activities online scheme management, database management.
  14. Providing manpower across State and headquarters as specified in the RFP.

***Note: A committee formed by Directorate of Fisheries will conduct Mid-Term review to appraise the performance of PIMC.***

### ii. Financial Bid:

## 10. Brief Description of the Selection Process

The Agency shall be selected through an open competitive bidding process. A two-stage selection process will be adopted in evaluating the Proposals. In the first stage, a technical evaluation will be carried out. In the second stage, a financial evaluation will be carried out.

## 11. Evaluation of Bids

- e) It has submitted Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Only) as Earnest Money Deposit (EMD in the form of BG or DD) and processing charges of Rs. 8,000/- (Rupees Eight Thousand Only) through DD.
- f) It is not non-responsive in terms hereof.

The Director of Fisheries, Directorate of Fisheries, Government of Bihar reserves the right to reject any Proposal which is non-responsive and no request for alteration, modification, substitution, or withdrawal shall be entertained by the Directorate of Fisheries, Government of Bihar in respect of such Proposals.

- i. The Agency obtaining at least **75% marks** on the basis of evaluation of the Technical Bid will qualify for evaluation of Financial Bid.
- ii. Further, the Technical Agency will be selected from the technically qualifying bidders based on selection criteria.

## 13. Evaluation of Financial Proposal

In the second stage, the financial evaluation will be carried out based on criteria given below:

- i. Only those bidders qualifying through the Technical Bid will be considered for financial evaluation.
- ii. The GST and other levies, if any, should be furnished as per the format.
- iii. In case nothing mentioned, it will be assumed that taxes / other levies are included in the rates quoted.
- iv. Rate should be quoted on comprehensive basis for carrying out all works as mentioned in the tender document.
- v. The selection method is **Least Cost Method (L<sub>1</sub>)**.
- vi. The Directorate of Fisheries would enter a contract with successful eligible bidder.

The undersigned reserves the right to enter price negotiation with the successful bidder to reduce the quoted price if the same is found to be irrational. An evaluation committee involving officers of Directorate under the chairmanship of Director would be formed to undertake the evaluation and selection process of PIMC.

The cost indicated in the Financial Proposal shall be deemed as final and reflecting the total cost of services. Omissions, if any, in costing any item shall not entitle the team to be compensated and the liability to fulfil its obligations as per the TOR within the total quoted price shall be that of the Consultant.

The Bidder shall be selected on the basis of **Least Cost Method (L1)**, the minimum qualifying marks will 75 in Technical evaluation. Financial proposal of only those agencies will be opened which has secured minimum **75 marks**.

For financial evaluation, the total cost indicated in the Financial Proposal will be considered without considering the GST.

Fisheries Directorate will determine whether the Financial Proposals are complete, unqualified and unconditional. The cost indicated in the Financial Proposal shall be deemed as final and reflecting the total cost of services. Omissions, if any, in costing any item shall not entitle the bidder to be compensated and the liability to fulfill its obligations as per the TOR within the total quoted price shall be that of the Consultant.

An evaluation committee involving officers of Directorate under the chairmanship of Director would be formed to undertake the evaluation and selection process of PIMC.

#### **14. Award of Assignment**

After selection, a Letter of Award shall be issued in duplicate by the Directorate of Fisheries, Government of Bihar to the Selected consulting agency and the consulting agency shall, within 7 (seven) days of the receipt of the LOA, sign and return the duplicate copy of the LOA in the acknowledgement thereof. The LOA shall constitute the Agreement for the purpose of this consultancy assignment.

#### **15. Terms of Payment**

Payment of professional fee will be made on monthly **basis** upon the submission of an invoice backed by Monthly Progress Reports outlining the areas covered in Terms of Reference of this RFP.

Payment of professional fees would be made **within two weeks** of submission of invoices.

#### **16. Penalty Clause**

For non-performance / delayed performance, the following penalties may be imposed on the PIMC:

- a) Forfeiture of Performance Security
- b) Directorate of Fisheries will reserve the right of performance review/evaluation of the selected agency.
- c) Deduction of 1% of fees of installment due to each week of delay or part thereof wherever any deadline is fixed subject to ceiling limit of 5% of professional fees due.

#### **17. Limitation of Liability**

The liability of the Project Implementation and Monitoring Unit (PIMC) whether in contract, tort, negligence, strict liability in tort, by statute or otherwise) for any claim in any manner related to this assignment, including the work, or Services covered under this assignment, shall be the payment of direct damages only which shall in no event in the aggregate exceed the Total Contract Value.

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## 18. Performance Guarantee / Security

Performance Security shall be obtained from the selected agency (successful bidder) in the form of Bank Guarantee(*Annexure VI*)/Demand Draft to the tune of 5% of the contract value.

After selection of suitable applicant (successful bidder), the EMD shall be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders. However, the Selected Applicant's EMD will be returned, without any interest, upon signing of the MoU and furnishing of the Performance Security to the tune of 5% of the total contract value.

Performance Security in the form of Bank Guarantee (to be retained by DoF) initially shall be valid till the end of this agreement (Contract) and in case the assignment extends beyond the period, the validity of the Bank Guarantee shall be suitably extended.

## 19. Removal and Replacement of Team members

If Directorate of Fisheries finds that any of the Experts or Sub-consultant has committed serious misconduct or has been charged with having committed a criminal action, or if the Directorate of Fisheries determines that a Consultant's Expert or Sub-consultant has engaged in Fraud and Corruption while performing the Services, the Consultant shall, at the Directorate of Fisheries written request, provide a replacement. In the event that any of Key Experts is found by the Directorate of Fisheries to have not performed as per desired standards then with a notice of one month Directorate of Fisheries may ask selected agency to replace the said expert with an Expert who is equally qualified or has higher experience than that mentioned in the RFP. However, for the change of the team member/s, his/her CV needs prior approval of Director Fisheries before deployment.

In case the performance of PIMC is found to be unsatisfactory after one year from the date of joining, then Directorate of Fisheries reserves the right to remove the agency and will be at the liberty to replace it with the next successful bidder at the cost of the former consultant given that it completes all necessary formalities.

If the next successful bidder fails to comply with the necessary formalities, then the subsequent bidder will be given an opportunity to replace the preceding selected agency.

## 20. Amendment to RFP

At any prior to the closing time and date of receipt of bids, the Directorate of Fisheries may for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by the prospective bidders, modify the RFP document by an amendment in order to provide prospective bidder reasonable time for taking the amendment into account in paring their bids, the Directorate of Fisheries may at its discretion, extend the last date for receipt of bids and/or make other changes in the requirements set out in the RFP.

## 21. Disclaimer

The Directorate of Fisheries shall not be responsible for any late receipt for any reasons whatsoever.

## 22. The Directorate of Fisheries reserves the right

a) To relax or waive any of the conditions stipulated in this document as deemed necessary in the best interest of the government and the objective of the scheme without assigning any reasons thereof.

b) To include an

b) To include any other items in the Terms of Reference at any time after consultation in the pre-bid meeting or otherwise.

c) To facilitate evaluation of Proposals, the Directorate of Fisheries may, at its sole discretion seek clarification from any Applicant regarding its Proposal. Such clarification(s) shall be provided within the time specified by the Directorate of Fisheries for this purpose. Any request for clarification(s) and all clarification(s) on response thereto shall be in writing. If a bidder does not provide clarifications sought above within the specified time, its proposal shall be liable to be rejected. In case the Proposal is not rejected, the Directorate of Fisheries may proceed to evaluate the Proposal by construing the particulars requiring clarification to the best of its understanding.

### 23. Right to reject any or all Proposals

Notwithstanding anything contained in the RFP, the Directorate of Fisheries reserves the right to accept or reject any Proposal and to annul the Selection Process and reject all Proposals at any time without any liability or any obligation for such acceptance, rejection, or annulment, and without assigning any reasons thereof.

The Directorate of Fisheries reserves the right to reject any Proposal if:

### 24. Miscellaneous

The Selection Process shall be governed by, and constructed in accordance with, the laws of State and India and the Court at Patna shall have exclusive jurisdiction over all disputes arising under, pursuant to and /or in connection with the Selection Process.

Office space for PIMC shall be provided by Directorate of Fisheries, Animal and Fisheries Resources Department, Govt. of Bihar. The consultant shall be responsible for development of MIS, website maintenance and hosting & backup of applications at State Data Centre/Local Data Centre/Cloud.

### 25. Validity of Proposal
