

1.* At AES-TAG (Technical Advisory Group) meeting held at RMRI, Patna on 29th November, 2016 and chaired by Dr. Soumya Swaminathan, Secretary DHR & DG, ICMR, New Delhi in presence of Principal Secretary, Health, Govt. of Bihar, Dr. S. Venkatesh, Director NCDC, Gol, Delhi, Dr. P. K. Sen, Additional Director, NVBDCP, Gol, Delhi and others, the decision taken was as- <u>"The cases diagnosed as Dengue, Malaria (Pf), Scrub Typhus and TB (TBM) should be removed from the AES pool to avoid unnecessary inflation in AES figure."</u>

2. As per above decision, Dengue, Malaria, Chikungunya, Scrub Typhus & Tuberculosis should be reported by concern technical division. These cases will not be reported as AES cases.
