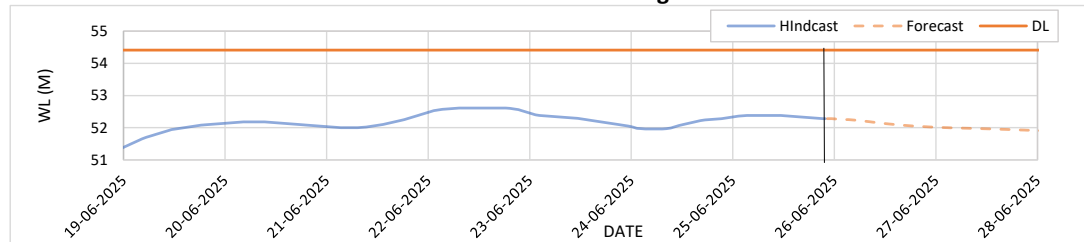
Forecast WL at Chatia

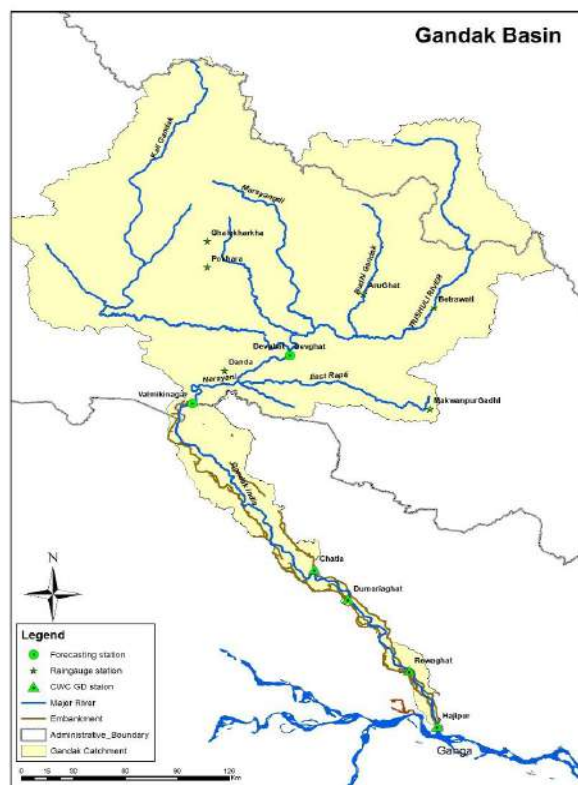

DISCHARGE FORECAST IN GANDAK RIVER BASIN

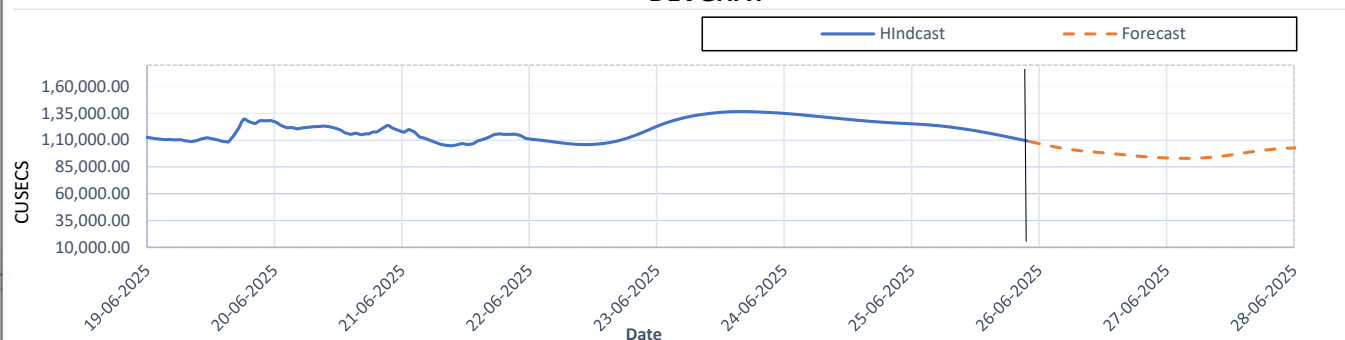

BIRPUR DISCHARGE FORECAST IN KOSI BASIN

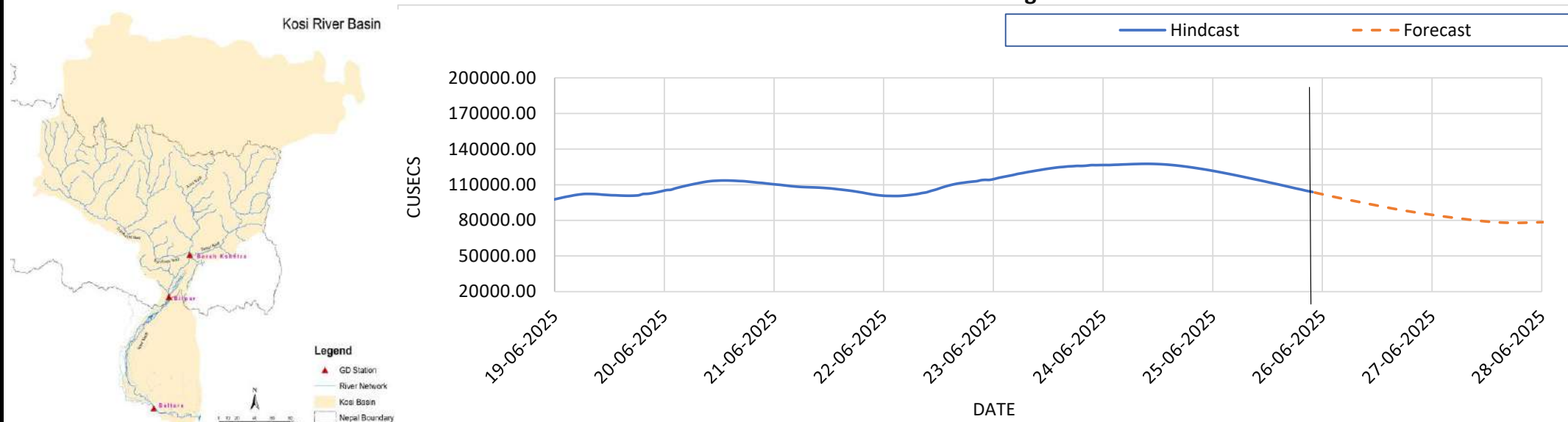

Forecast Discharge at BIRPUR

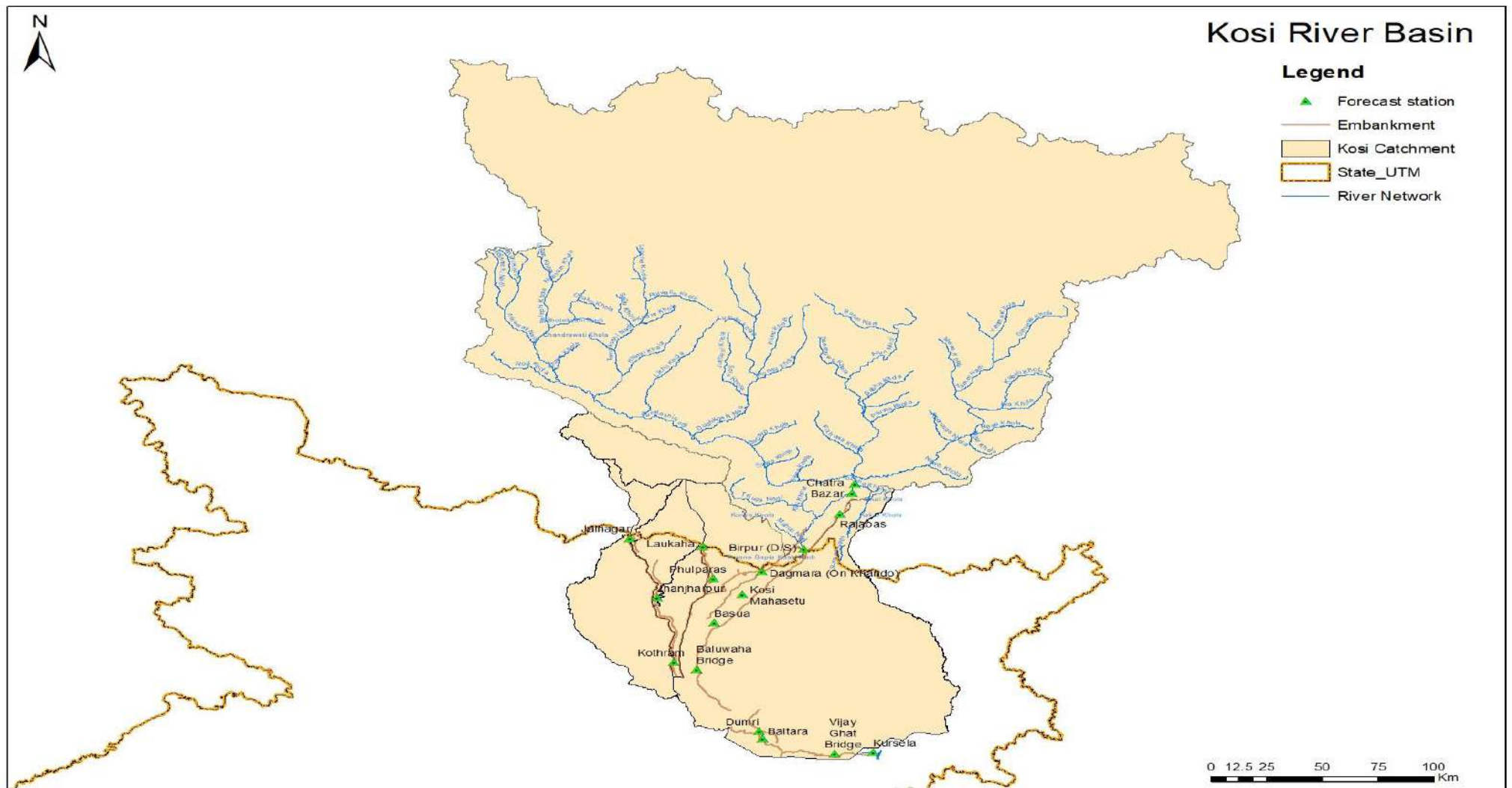
