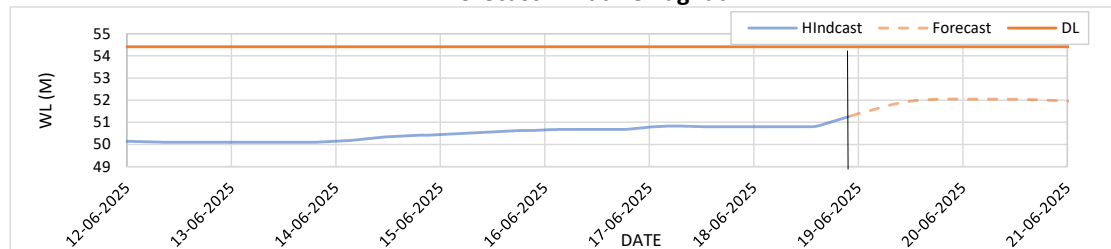
Forecast WL at Chatia



Forecast WL at Dumariaghat



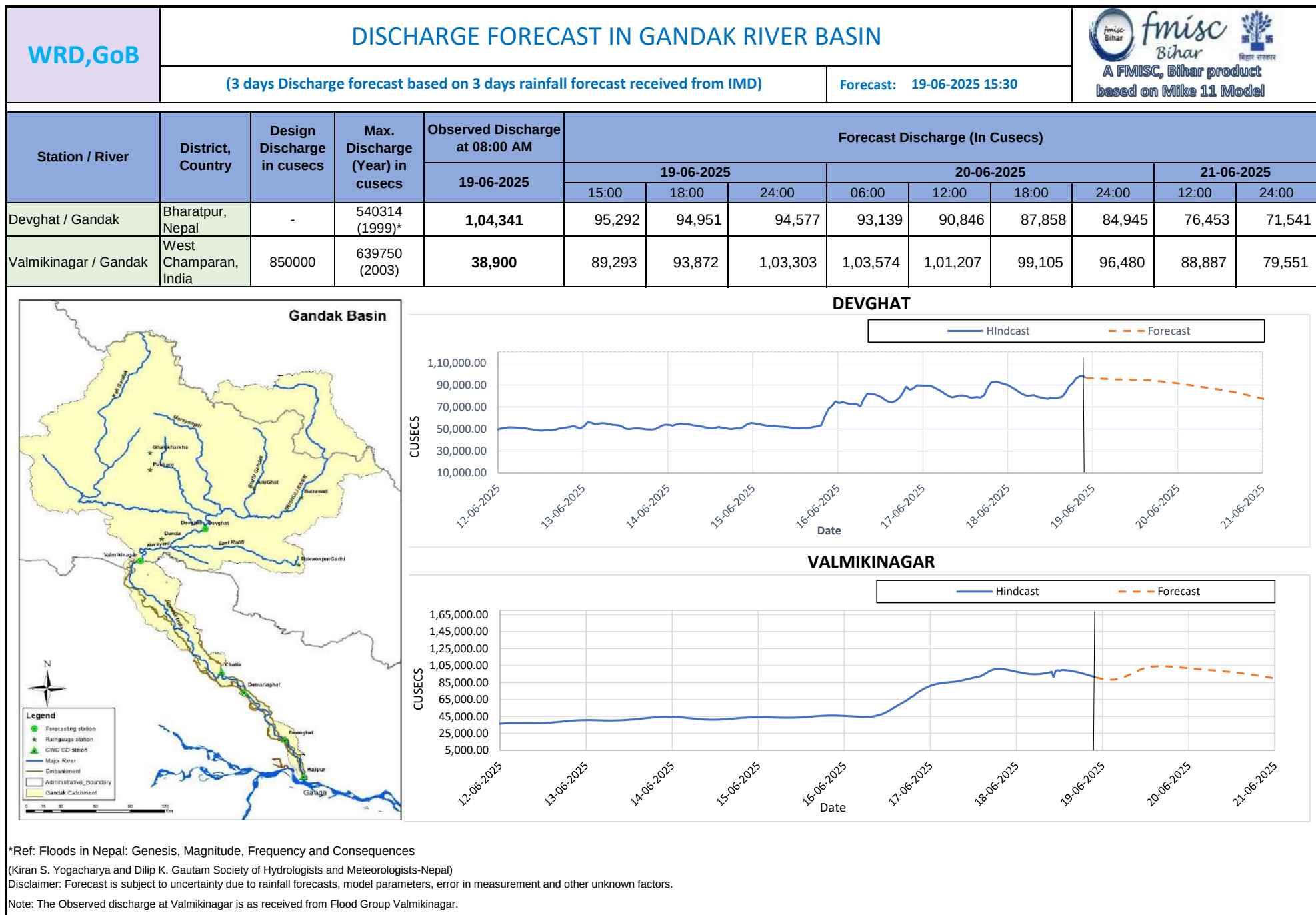

Water Level Forecast Sites in Bagmati Adhwarra Basin

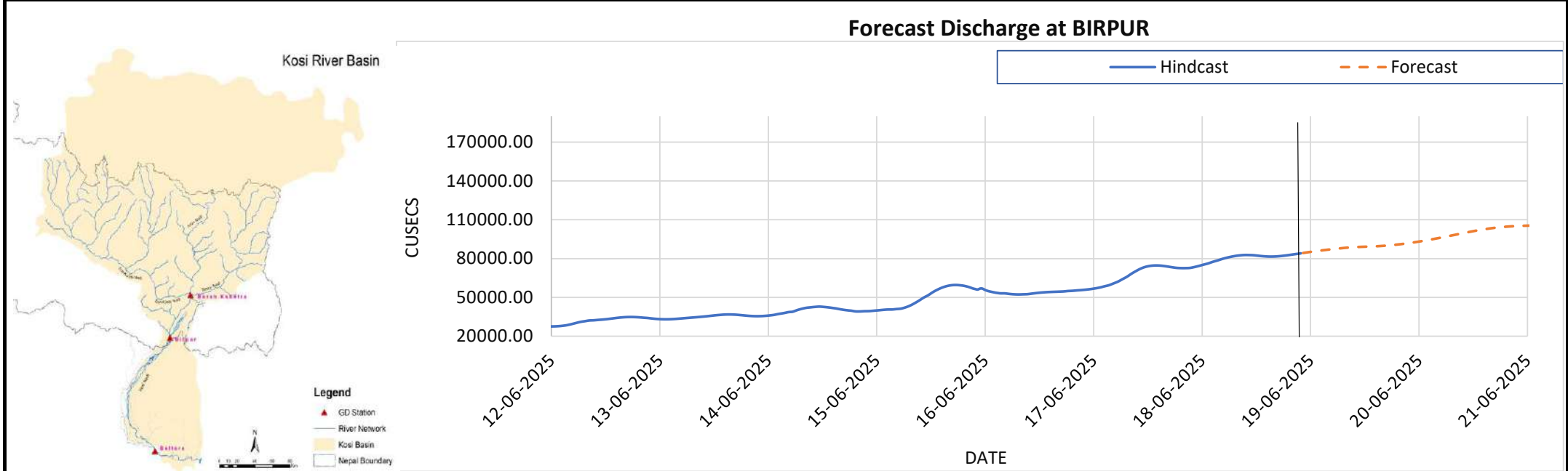
