

Counsel for appellant and DGM (Legal), BIADA are present.</p> <p>DGM (Legal) BIADA submitted reply and stated that the appellant has filed this appeal against the cancellation order and also submitted application for availing the benefit of Amnesty Policy, 2025. During examining the file, it was observed that without paying the transfer fee appellant has changed the constitution of the unit and therefore, dues of Rs. 4,07,449 is outstanding against the unit.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for the appellant urged that as per Clause 12.4 of the BIADA Land Allotment Policy if constitution is changed between the own blood relation then transfer fees may be exempted.</p> <p>DGM(Legal) BIADA stated that the transfer fee which has been demanded is regarding transfer previously made by the Appellant.</p> <p>Heard rival submissions of the parties. Amnesty Policy's pre-requisite condition for getting the in-principal approval from BIADA is that firstly all the outstanding dues must be cleared. Therefore, appellant is directed to pay the dues and then approach this forum.
