In exercise of the powers conferred under the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Bihar hereby makes the following Rules for appointment and determination of service conditions of employees of the **Bihar Subordinate Sports Cadre** under the Sports Department:

1. Short Title, Extent and Commencement.

- (i) These Rules may be called the "**Bihar Subordinate Sports Cadre (Recruitment and Service Conditions) Rules, 2025**".
- (ii) It shall extend to the whole of the State of Bihar.
- (iii) It shall come into force immediately on publication in official gazette.

2. Definitions- In these Rules, unless anything otherwise requires to the subject or context –

- (i) "Sports" means and includes all physical and intellectual activities whether performed individually or collectively and recognized as sports by the Indian Olympic Association. It must also be regulated by rules and regulations prescribed by National Sports Federation and played in Olympic Games/ Asian Games/ Commonwealth Games/ National Games.

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- (ii) "Sports events" means Any event relating to sports, which includes individual, dual, and team events, recognized by a authorized sports body administering the discipline.
- (iii) "State Government" means the State Government of Bihar,
- (iv) "Department or "Controlling Department" means the Sports Department;
- (v) "Appointing Authority" means the Additional Chief Secretary/Principal Secretary/Secretary, Sports Department;
- (vi) "Commission" means the Bihar Staff Selection Commission;
- (vii) "Cadre" means the Bihar Subordinate Sports Cadre;
- (viii) "Cadre Controlling Authority" means the Additional Chief Secretary/Principal Secretary/Secretary, Sports Department;
- (ix) "Member" means a person appointed to the Bihar Subordinate Sports Cadre;
- (x) "Appointed Date" means the date of coming into force of these Rules.

3. Structure of the Cadre-

- (i) The Structure of this cadre shall be as follows:-

Sl.No.	Designation	Level	Status
1	Sports Trainer	Basic Grade	Non-Gazetted

- (ii) All posts in the basic grade of this cadre shall be filled by direct recruitment.
- (iii) The sanctioned strength of posts of this cadre shall be the same as may be Prescribed/sanctioned by the State Government from time to time.
- (iv) This cadre will be of State level and will be under the administrative control of the Sports Department.
- (v) The posts in this cadre shall be allowed the same pay scale/pay level as may be prescribed/sanctioned by the State Government from time to time.
- (vi) The Sports Trainers appointed and working in Bihar Subordinate Sports and Youth Cadre under the control of Arts, Culture and Youth Department prior to the appointed date shall be deemed to be automatically appointed and working to the post of Sports Trainers of this cadre.

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- (vii) The members of this cadre may be posted at any place within the State. Any member of the cadre may be posted or deputed to any non-cadre post conforming to his qualification.

4. Eligibility/Qualification—

- (i) The minimum educational qualification for appointment to the post of basic grade of the cadre shall be a graduate degree from a recognized University.
- (ii) Candidate should have passed Diploma in Sports Coaching in the relevant sport from National Sports Institute run by Netaji Subhas National Institute of Sports (Sports Authority of India) or Post Graduate Diploma in Sports Coaching (PGDSC) course from Lakshmibai National Institute of Physical Education, Gwalior or a Central Sports University or any other sports university recognized by the UGC or Bihar Sports University.
- (iii) Sports achievement- Should have represented the country in a recognized International competition or represented the State in a National or International Championship. Recognized International competitions shall include, Olympic Games, Commonwealth Games, Asian Games, World Championships, Asian Championships, and other officially recognized annual International Championships or should have participated at least twice in All India Inter University/Recognized Junior Championship/National Youth Championship or 03 times in Inter Services Competition/All India Police Games/Inter Railway Championship.
- (iv) The minimum age of the candidate as on 1st August of the advertisement year shall be 21 years and the maximum age shall be the Same as may be determined by the State Government (General Administration Department).

5. Procedure of Selection-

- (i) The department shall calculate the available vacancies on 1st April every year and shall make available the requisition of available vacancies reservation category wise to the Commission by 30th April.
- (ii) The advertisement shall be published by the Commission for selection on the basis of the requisition received.

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(iii) The subject/interview and Syllabus for competitive examination to be held in the light of the advertisement shall be determined by the Commission as per the educational and technical qualification in consultation with the Department taking into account the syllabus of the regular course of Diploma in Sports Coaching of Sports Authority of India.

(iv) The Commission shall recommend reservation category wise appointment to the Department as per merit list prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the examination and interview.

(v) The candidates recommended by the Commission shall have to appear before the Medical Board constituted by the State Government. The recommendation of the concerned candidate shall be terminated for not fulfilling the requisite physical criteria as prescribed by the Department to execute the official duty efficiently.

6. Reservation- The provisions of reservation as prescribed by the State Government from time to time for appointment to the cadre shall apply.

7. Seniority-

(i) The inter se seniority of members appointed and working prior to the appointed date shall remain unchanged.

(ii) The members appointed and working prior to the appointed date shall be senior to the newly appointed employees after the appointed date.

(iii) The inter se seniority of the newly appointed employees in the cadre shall be in order of merit as determined by the Commission.

8. Probation Period-

(i) The members appointed to the basic grade of the cadre shall be on probation for 01 year from the date of joining. It may be extended by 01 more year for reasons to be recorded if the service is not found satisfactory during the probation period. The service may be terminated if the service is not found satisfactory even during the extended period.

(ii) In probation period, the newly appointed member shall have to successfully complete the training as prescribed by the Department.

9. Confirmation- The service shall be confirmed after satisfactory probation period, completion of training as prescribed in the probation period and after passing the Hindi Noting and Drafting Examination conducted by the Cabinet (Rajbhasha) Department and passing the Departmental Examination.

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10.Training- A member of this cadre shall be sent for higher level technical training or national/international training camps or event experience in the State or outside the State/Country for a period prescribed by the state.

11.Departmental Examination and Syllabus- The newly appointed Sports Trainers shall be required to pass in the prescribed departmental examination. The subject, syllabus and procedure of the departmental examination shall be determined by the Central Examination Committee, Revenue Board.

12.Residual Matters- The provisions enforced for employees of equivalent level of State Government shall also apply to members of this cadre with reference to the matter or matters in respect of which specific provision has not been made in these Rules.

13.Removal of Difficulties-

- (i) If, in the opinion of the Government, the enforcement of any provision of these Rules causes undue hardship to any member of the service or a group of members, the Government may, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the General Administration Department, relax such provision(s) to the extent necessary to remove such hardship.
- (ii) Any relaxation under this Rule shall be granted only in exceptional circumstances and shall not be inconsistent with the objectives and spirit of these Rules.
- (iii) The relaxation shall not confer any undue advantage or preferential treatment to any individual or group, and any such order shall be published in the official gazette for transparency.
- (iv) The Government may constitute a committee consisting of senior officers and subject-matter experts to examine and recommend whether relaxation is justified in each case.

14.Interpretation- Where there is any doubt in the interpretation of any provision of these rules the same shall be decided by the Department in consultation with General Administration Department/Law Department and its decision shall be final.

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15.Repeal and Savings –

- (i) The Bihar Subordinate Sports and Youth Cadre Rules, 2018 notified by the Department of Arts, Culture and Youth with reference to the members of this cadre are hereby repealed.
- (ii) Notwithstanding such repeal, any act done or any decision taken under the earlier Rules/Resolution/Instruction shall be deemed to have been done or taken under these Rules, as if these rules were enforced the day on which such act was done or decision was taken.
