


Respected Sir/Ma'am,

In continuation of the earlier communication wherein, the performance ranking of States/UTs on the iGOT Karmayogi platform was shared, the second edition of the consolidated ranking is now being communicated through this letter with all States/UTs. The objective of sharing these rankings on a periodic basis is to keep you apprised of the performance in terms of role-specific learning engagement and to promote continuous improvement.

2. Accordingly, a brief snapshot of the performance of each state/UT for the past month (December), along with its rank, has been provided in Annexure-1 for kind reference. The rankings are based on select Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) that broadly reflect organisational hygiene, user readiness, and role-based course consumption on the iGOT Karmayogi platform.

3. Additionally, I am pleased to inform that Karmayogi Bharat has launched the **iGOT Marketplace**, with **top quality, advanced courses** provided by eminent national and international universities, **available free of cost for iGOT users**. The list of courses arranged theme-wise has been provided in Annexure-2. Further, in view of rapidly evolving technology and emerging governance challenges, Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Cybersecurity have assumed critical importance. The same was highlighted during the recently concluded CS Conference. It is important that all government officials are adequately sensitised to contemporary developments, risks, and responsible application of AI and Cyber Security in public administration. In this context, I request you to kindly encourage all employees in the state/UT to take at least 1 course each on Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Cybersecurity by 31st March 2026, relevant to their respective roles and levels, from the list enclosed at Annexure-3.

5. In order to further strengthen data quality, learning outcomes, and implement role-based learning, States and UTs are once again requested to undertake the following actions on a priority basis:

a) **Cleaning of Organisational Data:** The state/UT along with their corresponding departments may kindly get their organisational hierarchy reviewed and updated on iGOT, ensuring that all subordinate organisations and units under its administrative control are correctly mapped on the platform.

b) **Updation of designation and profile information by users:** All onboarded users are required to verify and update their **designation and profile information** on the platform. The MDO Leader or designated Administrator is requested to validate these details for all officers. The updated user data is also available in the form of **downloadable reports and a dashboard on the MDO Portal**, which may be used for regular review and monitoring.

Creation of Capacity Building Plans: The state/UT, in collaboration with the ATI, is requested to create department-wise role-based capacity building plans. This can be accelerated using the recently developed AI based capacity building tool.

Course Development: The state/UT, in collaboration with the ATI, is also requested to identify and develop domain courses - courses pertaining to Acts/ Missions/ Schemes/ Programs/ Policies of the state government in the regional language. This will enable a more targeted capacity building of field level employees in the state/UT.

6. Your leadership, monitoring, and guidance are critical to the adoption of continuous, role-based learning in government. Karmayogi Bharat looks forward to your continued leadership of Mission Karmayogi in our pursuit of building a future-ready civil service.
