

I am inviting a reference to this Court's Letter No. 58496-589, dated 26.07.2024 & reminder no. 74964-65, dated 25.09.2024 on the above cited subject and to say that the matter related to exploring the possibility of adding one or two extra floors or more to existing court halls and residential unit could optimize the utilization of the existing infrastructure was considered in the meeting dated 11.07.2024 (copy enclosed) and Hon'ble Court had been pleased to resolve as follows:

"Approved. BCD shall survey the feasibility of existing building for adding floors where there is paucity of residential quarters and Court halls and place the comprehensive report after three months."

However, till date no response has been received.

I am, therefore, request you again to send the required report within two weeks so that the same could be placed under intimation to this Hon'ble Court.

This may be treated as most urgent.
