

NOTIFICATION

19th January 2026

No.-04/STA(Vividh)-31/2016-350.— Whereas, in view of the rapid economic development of the country and with a view to encourage movement of transport vehicles on the inter-state routes between States of Odisha and Bihar and to regulate and control their operation, it is highly necessary to enter into a supplementary reciprocal transport agreement.

Basing upon earlier discussion between two States, Government of Odisha published final notification under section 88 (6) of M.V. Act, 1988 in Odisha Gazette No.1440, dated 20.12.1995 and Government of Bihar published final notification in the Bihar Gazette vide No.65 dated 05.06.1995 regarding movement of transport vehicles on interstate routes and to regulate their operation and payment of taxes etc. for the convenience of general public.

In order to resolve issues cropped up during intervening period, it is felt necessary to hold further bilateral discussion between the Government of Odisha and Bihar to regulate movement of transport vehicles on interstate routes and to regulate their operation and payment of taxes etc. for the convenience of general public.

Due to division of Jharkhand State from Bihar in the year 2000 various old routes falling in Jharkhand, new reciprocal transport agreement between Odisha and Bihar shall replace all previous Interstate agreement between both the States e.g. agreement of 1988, 1991 and 1995 without affecting operation of existing Interstate bus services. Those operational bus services shall be included as part of present agreement.

On the above facts and conditions the Government of Bihar, Transport Department published the notice dated 15th May, 2025 inviting objection or suggestion in connection therewith in writing dated-31st May, 2025 from the date of publication of the said notice in the official Website. The conditions mentioned in the notice dated 15th May, 2025 shall be applicable to the present notification.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of sub-section (6) of Section 88 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988), the Government of Bihar do hereby publish the Supplementary Reciprocal Transport Agreement arrived at between the State of Odisha and Bihar, the terms and conditions of which have been set out in the Schedule below, namely :-

SCHEDULE

(The terms and conditions of the reciprocal transport agreement)

The reciprocal transport agreement shall remain valid till such time a new agreement between the two States is arrived at or the existing agreement is revoked after issue of six months notice by either States. Such revocation will not, however, affect the plying of vehicles covered by a permit already issued and or countersigned under this agreement.

1. The consolidated list of routes lying between Odisha & Bihar passing through Jharkhand has been annexed at Annexure-A.
2. Intensification of existing routes between Odisha and Bihar passing through Jharkhand has been annexed at Annexure-B.
3. On the basis of proposal of Odisha & Bihar, new interstate routes are to be opened for operation of stage carriages, details of which are mentioned at Annexure-C.
4. Once stage carriage permits are issued to any person from one STA, any application for stage carriage permit for the same route to the same person shall not be entertained by the Reciprocating State, unless the holder of permit surrendered the stage carriage permit held by him to that permit granting authority, with declaration that such person want to shift his transport business or made change of residence within jurisdiction of the Reciprocating State. Afterwards, STA from which he obtained stage carriage permit earlier will not issue any permit to respective applicant.
5. Transfer of stage carriage permit will be considered on case to case basis as per policy decision or rule prevailing in respective State.
6. List of permanent stage carriage permits granted/countersigned by STA, Bihar and STA, Odisha will be exchanged between two STAs electronically on bi-monthly basis to regulate plying of buses on Interstate routes to prevent unauthorized plying of stage carriages by evading tax.
7. State Transport Authority will Issue stage carriage permanent permit to bus owners of home State on any finally notified interstate route to stage carriages registered in the home State only as per prevailing rule or policy decision of respective State.
8. The case of hiring/lease of stage carriages will be considered on case to case basis as per policy decision or rule prevailing in respective State.
9. Replacement of vehicle will be considered only where the vehicle proposed to be replaced is of higher model.
10. Temporary permits shall not be issued to stage carriages on any non-agreed Interstate routes without publication of final notification under section 88 (6) of M.V. Act, 1988.

11. New permanent stage carriage permits and replacement of vehicle will be granted to vehicle as per bus body code AIS052 and AIS119 as amended from time to time and decision taken by respective State.
12. Keeping in view of convenience and comfort of long distance travelling public, stage carriages not exceeding ten years from the month/year of manufacture shall be allowed to operate in any interstate route lying between Odisha and Bihar. Stage carriages plying on interstate routes between Odisha and Bihar, on completion of ten years from the month/year of manufacture shall be replaced by higher model vehicle.
13. All vacant interstate routes will be published in the newspaper or departmental website of respective STA for wide publication for grant of permanent stage carriage permits to deserving vehicle owners.
14. **PERMITS FOR STAGE CARRIAGES:-**
 - I. The distance and nature of services are also mentioned in the said statement against each route, which shall be followed by both the States.
 - II. Unless a permanent permit granted by the home state is countersigned by the reciprocating State, no further permit on the self same route shall be granted to the permit holder. The permit holder while making application for subsequent grant/renewal of permit shall submit copy of previous countersignature duly authenticated.
 - III. Permanent stage carriage permits granted to the nominee of home state shall be countersigned by the reciprocating State.
 - IV. According to the provision of the said Act, the basis of permit shall be one permit per one vehicle and vehicle number shall be mentioned in each permit.
 - V. No standees shall be allowed on any Inter-State stage carriages.
 - VI. On all Inter-State routes, the stage carriages of the Home State shall have precedence on timings over the buses of the reciprocating State.
 - VII. Nature of services of all routes shall be express/deluxe/deluxe AC/deluxe AC sleeper/fully built AC sleeper etc depending upon type of bus.
 - VIII. The stage carriages plying on Inter-State routes between Odisha and Bihar shall carry destination board in Hindi and Odia.
 - IX. If a stage carriage makes two trips daily, the stage carriage shall start from the Home State and shall make night halt in the home State.
 - X. The distance mentioned against each route along with alignment thereof is considered as shortest and direct route. If any discrepancy is noticed in future regarding distance of the route, the route shall be surveyed by the respective State Transport Authorities and corrected through correspondences, which shall not be treated as modification of agreement.
15. **PERMITS FOR GOODS CARRIAGES:**
 - a. (i) **Permanent Permits.**—Permanent permits for Goods Carriage shall be issued by the respective State Transport Authority to be valid for all motor able roads of home State and reciprocating State except on prohibited roads subject to countersignature by

the respective State Transport Authority. There shall be no ceiling on grant of permanent permits for goods carriage.

(ii) The goods carriage shall not pick up or set down goods between two points lying in the same State other than the home State.

b. *Temporary Permits.*—Temporary permits may be issued by the home State in respect of goods carriages which shall remain operative in other State without countersignature.

16. PERMIT FOR CONTRACT CARRIAGE (MOTOR CAB)

1. (a) *Permanent Permits.*—To facilitate movement of tourist between two States substantive Motor Cab permit may be granted by each State mentioning therein route/area of both the States or for operation on all motor able roads of reciprocating State which shall be valid only after it is countersigned. There shall be no ceiling on grant of permanent contract carriage permits to motor cabs,

(b) *Temporary Permits.*—Temporary permit of this category may be issued as per need by the Transport Authority of one State which shall be valid without countersignature in the reciprocating State subject to condition that, the vehicle shall be hired by a single party.

2. PERMIT FOR CONTRACT CARRIAGES (OMNI BUS)

(a) *Permanent Permits.*—Permanent permits issued for contract carriage under section 74 of the said Act. may be granted by one State mentioning area of operation of both the States which shall remain operative in reciprocating State only after it is countersigned. There shall be no ceiling on grant of permanent permits for contract carriages.

(b) *Temporary Permits.*—Temporary permits to contract carriage (Omni buses) shall be issued as per need by transport authority of one State, which shall be valid without countersignature in the reciprocating State.

(c) Special permits issued under sub-section (8) of section 88 of the said Act. may be granted as per need by either of the State for a period not exceeding 30 (thirty) days.

17. PRIVATE SERVICE VEHICLE

(a) *Permanent Permits.*—Permanent permits issued by State Transport Authority under section 76 of the said Act in respect of private service vehicle mentioning area of operation of both the States shall remain operative in other State only after it is countersigned. There shall be no ceiling on grant of permanent permit for private service vehicle.

(b) *Temporary Permit.*—Temporary permit shall be granted under section 87 of the said Act to private Service vehicles as per need for a period not exceeding thirty days which shall be operative in the reciprocating State without countersignature.

18. FARE.—The fare for stage carriages chargeable for the kilometrage in the territory of each State shall be calculated at the rate prescribed by the respective State Government. The tickets issued in one State shall remain valid in other State.

19. **TAXATION.**—

- (1) (a) Taxes by various kinds of vehicles covered by this reciprocal agreement shall be payable as per the provisions contained in the Motor Vehicles Taxation Act and Rules of the respective State.
 - (b) Motor vehicles exclusively owned by Government of Odisha and Bihar used for Government purposes, shall be exempted from payment of all the taxes leviable in both the States.
 - (c) All transport vehicle not covered by any agreement while operating in the other State, shall be liable to pay all the taxes leviable in the other State.
 - (d) Exemption of Tax during off road period relating to stage carriages operating on interstate routes will be considered by respective State as per their prevailing rule.
- (2) **MODE OF PAYMENT OF TAX.**—Both the States shall ensure recovery of tax dues for reciprocating State. It shall be the duty of the permit holder of all class of vehicle except stage carriages to ensure payment of tax due for the other State before entering into the jurisdiction of that State. Stage carriage permit holders shall pay tax online before respective State Transport Authority.
- (3) **RECOVERY OF ARREAR TAX.**—Both the States will render necessary co-operation to collect arrear tax and penalty that would be due from the vehicles of the reciprocating State.

20. **GENERAL**

- (a) Each State shall accord recognition to Tax Token, Registration Certificates, Fitness Certificate, Driving License, Conductors License, Badges issued by the authority of reciprocating State.
- (b) The gross vehicle weight of a transport vehicle shall not exceed as per the limit fixed by the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways which shall be followed by both the States.
