ORAL ORDER

2 22-06-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the respondents.

2. The petitioner has filed the instant application for
the following reliefs:

*"(i) For issuance of an order/direction or an
appropriate writ including the writ of mandamus
commanding the Respondents to look into the
construction of Panchayat Govt. Bhawan in the
headquarter area of Sonvarsha Panchayat of
District Bhojpur.*

(ii) For issuance of an order, direction or an

appropriate writ to the Respondents to adhere the guidelines for construction of Panchayat Govt. Bhawan under Sonvarsha Panchayat of District Bhojpur and construction of Panchayat Bhawan at Ettor village in said panchayat be stopped.

(iii) For issuance of an order, direction or an appropriate declaration holding that Respondents have to safeguard the interest and welfare of the society by allowing construction of proper Panchayat Govt Bhawan at the appropriate place of the said Panchayat.

(iv) For any other relief or reliefs for which the petitioner may be entitled in the facts and circumstances of this case."

3. Though the petitioner has brought on record a copy of the written representation filed by him for the reliefs prayed for herein addressed to the District Magistrate, Bhojpur, Ara as Annexure-P/3 to the writ application, however there is no receipt on the same.

4. In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to file a fresh representation before the District Magistrate, Bhojpur (respondent no.3) seeking the reliefs prayed for in the instant writ application within a period of 4 weeks.

5. On the same being filed, the respondent concerned

shall decide the same in accordance with law within a period of 3 months from the date of its filing and communicate the results thereof to the petitioner expeditiously.

6. The writ application stands disposed of with the above observations and directions.
