उपर्युक्त तालिका के आधार पर कुछ परियोजना हेतु अनुमान्य केन्द्रांश की राशि का व्यय पूर्व में किया जा चुका है, जिसके कारण उक्त परियोजना हेतु CFMS 2.0 के SNA SPARSH Module अंतर्गत

समर्पित विपत्र को विधि एवं न्याय मंत्रालय (न्याय विभाग) द्वारा अस्वीकृत किया गया है। उल्लेखनीय है कि किसी एक e-Payment File के एक विपत्र को अस्वीकृत किये जाने की स्थिति में उक्त e-Payment File में शामिल सभी विपत्रों को वापस किया गया है, क्योंकि PD, Department of Justice के स्तर पर विपत्रों को अलग-अलग नहीं किया जा सकता है।

अतः इस संदर्भ में विधि एवं न्याय मंत्रालय (न्याय विभाग), भारत सरकार, नई दिल्ली तथा माननीय उच्च न्यायालय, पटना से प्राप्त पत्र की प्रति संलग्न करते हुए निम्न निदेश दिया जाता है:-

- (01) योजना की अनुमान्यता के आलोक में भुगतान हेतु अवशेष केन्द्रांश एवं राज्यांश की राशि का आकलन करते हुए अनुमान्य राशि तक का ही विपत्र स्वीकृति हेतु CFMS 2.0 के SNA SPARSH Module के माध्यम से भारत सरकार के पास समर्पित किया जाय। साथ ही संबंधित e-Payment Voucher का विवरण नियमित रूप से न्याय विकास पोर्टल पर अपलोड किया जाय।
- (02) केन्द्रांश एवं राज्यांश हेतु अनुमान्य राशि से अधिक परियोजना/निर्माण कार्य का लागत आने की स्थिति में अतिरिक्त लागत से संबंधित प्रतिवेदन विभाग को यथाशीघ्र उपलब्ध कराया जाय, ताकि अतिरिक्त भुगतान के संदर्भ में अग्रेत्तर कार्रवाई हेतु विधि विभाग को भेजा जा सके।
- (03) विधि विभाग से संबंधित केन्द्र प्रायोजित योजना अंतर्गत कार्यों की विवरणी न्याय विकास पोर्टल पर अपलोड/अपडेट/जियो टैगिंग किये जाने हेतु Add new tab दिनांक-15.07.2026 से दिनांक-31.07.2026 तक enable किया गया है। उक्त कार्य के लिए पूर्व में भी निदेशित किया गया है, परंतु कृत कार्रवाई की सूचना अबतक अप्राप्त है। अतः न्याय विकास पोर्टल पर उक्त योजनाओं की विवरणी अपलोड/जियो टैगिंग एवं राशि के व्यय हेतु योजना के प्राथमिकता निर्धारित किये जाने की कार्रवाई दिनांक-31.07.2026 तक अचूक रूप से पूर्ण कर लिया जाय।

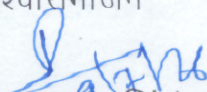

Sub: Clarification and reason of returning on the PFMS portal of the ePayment files relating to CSS for Development of Infrastructure Facilities in District and Subordinate Courts - regarding

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Department's e-mail dated 02.06.2026 regarding information required from all States/UTs for clearance of their ePayment files on PFMS portal and to say that this Department is in receipt of number of representations from various States seeking clarification regarding returning of their ePayment files.

2. In this regard, it may please be noted that the admissible component-wise cost ceilings under the CSS is as under:

3. It is apprised that the project-wise details of various bills submitted by the States/UTs in ePayment files on the PFMS portal are not visible to the Programme Division (PD) in Department of Justice. To sort this out, initially a format was devised and the relevant information was sought from the States concerned. On examination of this information submitted by some of the States, the following three type of cases were found:

Suo

(i) Some bills are not eligible as central funds admissible for the project (i.e. the cost mentioned in table above multiplied by the number of Court Halls, RU etc in the project) have already been released. E.g. for a project having 4 Court Halls, 2 RUs and 1 Lawyers' Hall in Madhya Pradesh, funds to the tune of only Rs 3,94,42,972/- ($57,69,231 \times 4 + 57,69,231 \times 2 + 48,27,586 \times 1$) can be released even if the project costs Rs 15 crore.

(ii) Some ePayment files have not been approved because they contained bills for one or more of ineligible projects [i.e. the projects for which no more central funds can be released as discussed in point (i) above]. In such cases, the complete ePayment file has to be returned, as un-clubbing cannot be done at the level of PD, DoJ.

(iii) The ePayment files containing eligible bills as per the calculations at point (i) above have been approved on regular basis by the PD, DoJ.

4. In view of the above position, the States/UTs are requested to calculate their balance eligibility for central funds in a project and take further necessary action and submit only the eligible bills on PFMS portal.

5. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.

Record of Discussion of the Online Session held on 09.07.2026 for States/UTs on the New Functionalities of the Nyaya Vikas Portal under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for Development of Infrastructure Facilities for District and Subordinate Courts.

An online session was held on 09.07.2026 (03.00 PM) under the chairmanship of Shri Satya Pratap Singh, Joint Secretary, Department of Justice through video conference with representatives of the States/UTs and High Courts. The purpose of the session was to familiarize the participants with the newly introduced functionalities on the Nyaya Vikas Portal, namely Project Prioritisation and updation of e-payment voucher (EPV) details under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for Development of Infrastructure Facilities for District and Subordinate Courts. At the outset, the Chair welcomed all the participants and emphasized the importance of timely adoption of the new functionalities for effective monitoring of projects under the Scheme.

2. The technical team from NRSC-ISRO made a detailed presentation and demonstrated the newly introduced modules on the Nyaya Vikas Portal. The procedure for project prioritisation and updating of EPV details linked with bills generated through PFMS was explained at length.

3. Joint Secretary advised all States/UTs to verify the details of ongoing projects and their respective components available on the Nyaya Vikas Portal and to rectify any discrepancies, wherever required. States/UTs were further requested to complete project prioritisation at the earliest and regularly update EPV details to facilitate effective monitoring of fund utilisation and project progress.

4. During the interactive session, representatives of the States/UTs sought clarifications on various aspects relating to the newly introduced functionalities of the Nyaya Vikas Portal and the implementation of the Scheme. The queries primarily pertained to updating of EPV details, admissible infrastructure components, project prioritization, modifying/updating details of projects on the Portal, financial assistance for ongoing/new projects, and normative costs of approved infrastructure components. The following clarifications were provided by the Chair: -

i. Updating EPV details on the Nyaya Vikas Portal is essential for mapping expenditure to the respective project and component, thereby enabling project-wise monitoring of utilization of Central funds. Accordingly, States/UTs were advised to update EPV details on the Nyaya Vikas Portal simultaneously with the corresponding entries on PFMS Portal.

ii. The financial assistance under the Scheme is restricted to the approved infrastructure components. The Scheme does not discuss components such as CCTV, air-conditioning and furniture. It was further clarified that expenditure on computers is covered under the e-Courts Project.

iii. Requests relating to merger of multiple projects or editing the status of projects that are physically completed but financially incomplete may be submitted to the Department of Justice for examination and necessary action. After examination, necessary action will be taken in coordination with NRSC-ISRO.

iv. Requests were made by few States to activate "Add new projects" option on the Nyaya Vikas Portal to enable States/UTs to add ongoing projects which have been missed

Record of Discussion of the Online Session held on 09.07.2026 for States/UTs on the New Functionalities of the Nyaya Vikas Portal under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for Development of Infrastructure Facilities for District and Subordinate Courts.

An online session was held on 09.07.2026 (03.00 PM) under the chairmanship of Shri Satya Pratap Singh, Joint Secretary, Department of Justice through video conference with representatives of the States/UTs and High Courts. The purpose of the session was to familiarize the participants with the newly introduced functionalities on the Nyaya Vikas Portal, namely Project Prioritisation and updation of e-payment voucher (EPV) details under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for Development of Infrastructure Facilities for District and Subordinate Courts. At the outset, the Chair welcomed all the participants and emphasized the importance of timely adoption of the new functionalities for effective monitoring of projects under the Scheme.

2. The technical team from NRSC-ISRO made a detailed presentation and demonstrated the newly introduced modules on the Nyaya Vikas Portal. The procedure for project prioritisation and updating of EPV details linked with bills generated through PFMS was explained at length.

3. Joint Secretary advised all States/UTs to verify the details of ongoing projects and their respective components available on the Nyaya Vikas Portal and to rectify any discrepancies, wherever required. States/UTs were further requested to complete project prioritisation at the earliest and regularly update EPV details to facilitate effective monitoring of fund utilisation and project progress.

4. During the interactive session, representatives of the States/UTs sought clarifications on various aspects relating to the newly introduced functionalities of the Nyaya Vikas Portal and the implementation of the Scheme. The queries primarily pertained to updating of EPV details, admissible infrastructure components, project prioritization, modifying/updating details of projects on the Portal, financial assistance for ongoing/new projects, and normative costs of approved infrastructure components. The following clarifications were provided by the Chair: -

i. Updating EPV details on the Nyaya Vikas Portal is essential for mapping expenditure to the respective project and component, thereby enabling project-wise monitoring of utilization of Central funds. Accordingly, States/UTs were advised to update EPV details on the Nyaya Vikas Portal simultaneously with the corresponding entries on PFMS Portal.

ii. The financial assistance under the Scheme is restricted to the approved infrastructure components. The Scheme does not discuss components such as CCTV, air-conditioning and furniture. It was further clarified that expenditure on computers is covered under the e-Courts Project.

iii. Requests relating to merger of multiple projects or editing the status of projects that are physically completed but financially incomplete may be submitted to the Department of Justice for examination and necessary action. After examination, necessary action will be taken in coordination with NRSC-ISRO.

iv. Requests were made by few States to activate "Add new projects" option on the Nyaya Vikas Portal to enable States/UTs to add ongoing projects which have been missed

to get uploaded/geotagged on Nyaya Vikas Portal but are currently ongoing and Co funding is required for such projects. Joint Secretary assured the States/UTs that necessary action on their request will be taken.

v. Under the extended Scheme, priority would be accorded to completion of ongoing/under-construction projects. At present, no financial assistance is proposed for new projects and States/UTs were advised to prioritise completion of ongoing projects before taking up new ones.

vi. With regard to concerns raised by the North-Eastern States regarding higher construction costs, it was informed that the applicable funding pattern under the Scheme would continue to be followed. It was further clarified that the normative cost of infrastructure components has been derived based on the NCMS report and subsequent assessment by CPWD.

vii. The indicative normative cost (Central + State) of the approved infrastructure components was shared (as per present guidelines) as under:

- Court Hall – Rs. 96 lakh
- Residential Unit – Rs. 96 lakh
- Lawyers' Hall – Rs. 80 lakh
- Toilet Complex – Rs. 5.40 lakh
- Digital Computer Room – Rs. 2.63 lakh

5. The Chair advised all States/UTs to promptly report any technical issues encountered while using the new functionalities to the Department of Justice or NRSC-ISRO for timely resolution. States/UTs were also requested to ensure that the information uploaded on the Nyaya Vikas Portal remains accurate, complete and up to date.

6. The Chair appreciated the active participation of the representatives from the States/UTs and High Courts. The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks.

Kindly refer to this Department email dt 21.05.2026 vide which DO letter from Secretary (Justice) to Law/Home Secretaries of all States was forwarded wherein it was requested to ensure utilization of Central share of funds only for Ongoing Projects and not for any new project, at present. Therefore, the tab "Add New Project" on NVP was disabled.

However, during the online session conducted for all States/UTs related to recently introduced "New functionality on Nyaya Vikas Portal" on 09.07.2026 for demonstrating the procedure related to Project prioritization and filling of details of EPV files on NVP, a few States requested to enable the tab of "Add New Project" on NVP as some projects which are already under construction have been left out from uploading/geo tagging on NVP and now States are finding it difficult to raise bills against such projects.

Apropos the discussions taken place *inter-alia* during the VC meeting on 09.07.2026, it has been now decided to enable the tab of "Add New Projects" for facilitating uploading the missed/left out Ongoing projects only, where at least some amount of Central Share have already been utilized. The facility will be opened on Nyaya Vikas portal only for a period of **two weeks starting from 15th July 2026 to 31 July 2026**. Necessary action may be taken accordingly.
