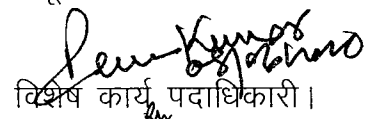

Respected Sir/Madam,

As you know, Emergency Departments are pivotal during Mass Casualty Incidents (MCIs). Trained human resources are essential to ensure organised, high-quality emergency care and save more lives during MCIs. To address this, the MoHFW under the Central Sector Scheme PM-ABHIM, has launched the “Mass Casualty Management (MCM) Programme for Frontline Healthcare Staff in Emergency Units” with an aim to establish standardised, globally aligned practices for mass casualty management, enabling healthcare teams to strengthen systems for effective response.

To achieve this, MoHFW has planned a nationwide rollout through Master Training Institutes in a cascading manner across the country, with JPNATC, AIIMS New Delhi serving as the Lead Centre for the programme.

As our AIIMS Patna is a Master Training Institute, we are conducting 03 days provider course at AIIMS Patna from 27th -29th July 2026.

In this regard, we request you to kindly nominate four permanent staff members (senior faculty from Emergency Care, Critical Care, Hospital Administration, senior nursing staff from Emergency, Disaster Nodal officer, etc.) from Patna Medical College & Hospital- Patna, Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences Patna, Nalanda Medical College and Hospital, Patna & ANMCH Gaya to attend the 03-days provider course. Kindly instruct the concerned Director/ Principle and Medical superintendent for the needful.

These nominations must reach by 15th June 26.

The trainees will initially be required to arrange their own travel and stay. The travel and stay expenses related to the course will be reimbursed by JPNATC, AIIMS New Delhi after the training (upon submission of original bills) as per MoHFW norms.

We look forward to your support in strengthening the national capacity on Mass Casualty Management.

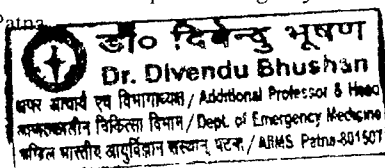

Guidelines for MCM Provider Course Allowance

This is regarding the "Mass Casualty Management Programme for Frontline Healthcare Staff working in Emergency Units" under the Central Sector Scheme "Pradhan Mantri Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission (PM - ABHIM)" funded by MoHFW

The Lead Centre for Training (JPNATC AIIMS New Delhi) will be reimbursing the entitled allowances to the trainees as per the norms

Category	Accommodation	Travel	Honorarium
Nominated Trainees (Doctors, Nurses) from institutes other than the host institution	3,500 per night per person for maximum 4 nights	- Air Economy Class - Train AC 2nd Class - Taxi (according to state govt taxi rates) or 30 Rs /km - Travel fare (roundtrip) should not exceed 20,000/-	500 per day for 3 days
Nominated Trainees (Doctors, Nurses) from the host institution	Not Applicable	Not Applicable	500 per day for 3 days

Note:

- Trainees from institutes other than the host institution are requested to arrange their own travel and accommodation (as per norms) near the course venue
- Nominated trainees will receive the allowances after the completion of the training, subject to submission of required documents to the MCM Course Team at the host institute

The following documents are required for reimbursement

- **For stay reimbursement:** Original accommodation bills duly signed & stamped by the hotel and self-attested by the trainee
- **For travel reimbursement:** Original travel tickets/taxi bills duly signed by the driver and self-attested by the trainee. In case of travel by personal vehicle, an undertaking/declaration must be submitted (form will be shared in WhatsApp group)
- **For bank details:** A copy of a cancelled cheque/first page of the bank passbook/e-statement clearly displaying the Account Holder Name, Account Number, and IFSC Code of an active bank account

****Incomplete, unclear, or incorrect documents may lead to cancellation of reimbursement claims**

- Any replacement of trainees must be officially communicated to both the host institute and JPNATC, AIIMS New Delhi, and will be accepted only through the proper channel
